Studying Scenarios:

- Applying value engineering to reduce costs in a design-build project.

- Assessing the impact of location and size adjustments on project costs.
- Implementing risk analysis and contingency planning in a high-risk project.
- Utilizing learning curves to estimate durations and costs in manufacturing projects.
- Applying cost indices to adjust estimates for inflation.
- Developing a pre-construction services estimate for a complex project.

Course Content:

Unit 1: Cost Estimating Fundamentals:

- Understanding the estimated project lifecycle.
- Exploring phases of the design process: programming, schematic design, design development, and construction documents.
- Assessing and estimating accuracy by phase.
- Developing conceptual cost estimates.
- Creating rough order of magnitude estimates.
- Utilizing assembly cost estimates and cost indices.
- Preparing semi-detailed and definitive estimates.
- Implementing basic estimating procedures.
- Understanding different contract types: lump-sum, unit-price, cost-plus, and time-and-materials.
- Exploring bid and negotiated methods.
- Conducting quantity take-offs.
- Analyzing procurement methods and pre-construction services.

- Performing risk analysis and incorporating contingencies.

Unit 2: Broad Scope Estimating Techniques:

- Adjusting project costs for broad scope estimates.
- Applying the PERT project cost analysis.
- Utilizing standard distribution curves and Z-value tables.
- Estimating project unit costs using standard deviation.
- Evaluating project unit costs at required probabilities.
- Adjusting estimates based on previous projects and time factors.
- Reviewing the future and present value of money.
- Calculating equivalent annual interest rates and compound interest.
- Applying location and size indices for construction.
- Implementing economic price adjustments.
- Estimating durations and costs using learning curves.

Unit 3: Budget Estimating Process:

- Estimating costs by design phase: programming, schematic design, and design development.
- Estimating pre-construction services.
- Developing requests for proposals and pre-construction services estimates.
- Creating pre-construction services contracts.
- Managing budget control logs.

Unit 4: Bid Contract Estimating Process:

- Conducting pre-estimate activities.
- Estimating processes for lump-sum bids.
- Developing work breakdown structures.
- Organizing, estimating teams, and scheduling estimating work.
- Coordinating with subcontractors and major suppliers.
- Utilizing estimating forms and ensuring accuracy.
- Pricing self-performed work and applying pricing factors.
- Summarizing materials, labor, and subcontractor work.
- Reviewing project summary schedules.
- Applying alternative techniques and estimating general conditions.
- Completing bid summaries and final mark-ups.
- Validating estimates and estimating subcontractor work.

Unit 5: Unit Price Estimating:

- Developing unit price bid forms.
- Estimating direct costs: materials, labor, indirect labor, and subcontractors.
- Creating recap summary sheets.
- Determining direct-to-indirect cost factors.
- Establishing mark-up determinations.
- Managing variation-in-quantity contract provisions.
- Conducting risk analysis and bid finalization.
