



PHP Development and API Integration Fundamentals



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Introduction

Course Content

Unit 1: PHP Development and Programming Foundations

- Understand PHP for dynamic web applications and backend systems.
- Explore statements, variables, constants, expressions, and program structures.
- Examine PHP data types, including strings, numbers, booleans, arrays, objects, and null.
- Understand arithmetic, assignment, comparison, logical, and string operators.
- Explore conditional structures for decision-making.
- Understand loops for repetitive data processing.
- Explore functions, parameters, return values, and reusable logic.

Unit 2: Core PHP Application Development

- Understand indexed, associative, and multidimensional arrays.
- Explore PHP methods for text manipulation and validation.
- Understand how PHP processes web form and browser data.
- Examine input validation and sanitization for secure data handling.
- Understand HTTP requests and server responses in PHP.
- Explore classes, objects, properties, methods, and encapsulation.
- Examine PHP errors, exceptions, and controlled error handling.

Unit 3: REST API and HTTP Communication Fundamentals

- Understand how APIs enable application-to-application communication.

- Explore API providers, consumers, resources, endpoints, requests, and responses.
- Understand REST principles and stateless communication.
- Explore GET, POST, PUT, PATCH, and DELETE methods.
- Interpret HTTP status codes for successful and failed requests.
- Understand JSON structures and their relationship with PHP data.
- Examine parameters, headers, and request bodies in API communication.

Unit 4: PHP API Integration and API Development

- Understand how PHP applications connect with external APIs.
- Explore HTTP methods, headers, parameters, and request bodies.
- Understand JSON decoding, validation, and response processing.
- Explore API keys, bearer tokens, and authentication methods.
- Identify authorization, connection, and server errors.
- Understand how API data supports dashboards, reports, and applications.
- Connect endpoints, authentication, requests, responses, and data processing.

Unit 5: Secure and Reliable PHP API Development

- Understand security principles for PHP applications and APIs.
- Examine secure handling of keys, tokens, passwords, and credentials.
- Validate user input and external API data before processing.
- Handle timeouts, unavailable services, invalid data, and connection failures.
- Understand API rate limits and communicate responsibly.
- Explore filtering, mapping, formatting, and organizing API data.
- Test API requests, authentication, responses, validation, and errors.
- Apply structured logic, secure data handling, and reliable error management.
